FIELD WORK: Total Marks 600, Per Semester 150 Marks

- I) The respective affiliated institutes/colleges are to develop field work modules and manuals based on the available field opportunities in their region. Field work over the four semesters will include concurrent field work, orientation visits, special awareness campaigns, rural camps, study tours, and block field work placements.
- II) Field work is allocated 150 marks (6 credits) for each semester, totaling 600 marks (24 credits) over four semesters.
- III) Field work will be conducted over a period of two days a week for a total of 15 clock hours.
- IV) Field work will be carried out at a social welfare agency/organization/industry selected by the college. Every student will be supervised by an experienced professional social worker from the agency and a faculty member of the college.
- V) A weekly individual conference of about 15 minutes, related to field work for each student, will be conducted by the concerned field work supervisor.

- VI) Field work will be evaluated internally by a panel of three faculty members, including the field work supervisor. Ninety percent attendance in field work is compulsory.
- VII) A student failing in field work in any semester will be declared as 'Fail' and will have to repeat the entire semester, including theory courses.
- VIII) In any case, there will be no revaluation or moderation of field work marks.
- IX) Rural Camp: Participation in a rural camp of 5-7 days organized by the college is compulsory for every student appearing for the second semester exam. The rural camp is a graded activity aimed at developing students' understanding of rural communities and the problems for intervention. Thirty marks are allotted to this activity under the head of field work. Students' performance will be assessed based on their participation, initiative, skills, and discipline.

STUDY TOUR

A study tour is compulsory for students of M.S.W IV Semester. This graded activity is designed to orient students to field realities and provide exposure to social work settings and their challenges. Out of the 150 marks allocated for field work, 30 marks are allotted to the study tour. Student performance will be assessed based on participation, report writing, skills, and discipline. The study tour will last 6 to 8 days and can be in an urban setting, a rural setting, or a mix of both, depending on the students' specialization. During the tour, students must visit at least four developmental agencies/organizations/projects/industries, with at least two relevant to their specialization group. The institution will organize this tour during the fourth semester.

- XII) Skill Lab is a non-graded learning activity organized to develop students' skills, helping them relate theory to practice and fostering professional development.
- XIII) Special Awareness Campaigns: Students will participate in special awareness campaigns, such as those on HIV/AIDS awareness, child labor issues, the environment, and civil rights, organized by the college under the guidance of a faculty supervisor. At least two issue-based campaigns should be organized during the semester.
- XIV) Issue-Based Paper, Book Review, Website Review Presentation: Every student must make at least one presentation on social issues and agencies working on them, book reviews, etc., during the semester.


