DETAILS OF THE NSS PROGRAMS – 2020-21

On 24/09/2020 National Service Scheme Day was celebrated through the college as per the circular of the university. Since it is not possible to call volunteers to the college during the corona period, the principal of the college, National Service Scheme Program Officer Dr. Asmita Sarvaiya Assistant Program Officer Vijaykumar Waghmare conveyed the importance of the National Service Scheme to the volunteers by giving a link through Google Meet. Hon. Principal explained the purpose of the scheme. 50 volunteers and former program officers of the college were present for the said program.

Report No. 02- M. Weekly program planning on the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti-

Dated 02/10/20 m. On the occasion of Gandhi Jayanti, volunteers of the National Service Scheme conducted programs in the areas where they live to adopt Mahatma Gandhi's thoughts about Swachh Bharat by planning a weekly program to clean the area and create public awareness. At the local level, public awareness was created regarding cleanliness. The message of cleanliness was conveyed through poster exhibition, activities were carried out at the local level with the help of Gram Panchayat and local Swaraj Sanstha. About 50 volunteers of National Service Scheme participated for this.

Report No.03- My Family My Responsibility Sahavichar Sabha

Hon. According to the circular of the university, in order to stop the outbreak of corona situation, on 11/10/20, Hon. Principal Dr. P.S. Under Patil's guidelines, Dr. National Service Scheme Program Officer of Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru College of Social Work. Asmita Saravaiya Assistant Program Officer Vijayakumar Waghmare organized a brainstorming session on My Family My Responsibility through Google Meet. 30 Volunteers, Program Officers and Principals from National Service Scheme Local Unit participated in My Family My Responsibility.

Report No. 04- Direct participation of volunteers in vaccination program of children in Anganwadi –

Considering the situation of Corona, d. On 15/10/20, volunteers from the local National Service Scheme Unit participated directly in the immunization program for children in the Anganwadi at the residence. During the epidemic, the local health department advised the people in the rural areas about the vaccination of children but did not receive any response. Interacted with Asmita Saravaiya and requested to directly participate in the campaign. Considering the situation of Corona, taking care of oneself and following the rules of the government and the university gave permission, the result was that the vaccination campaign of the government was successful. 35 students participated in this activity. Support was received from women, children and health workers in the local area.

Report No. 05 - Public awareness regarding mask, sanitizer social distancing during Corona epidemic -

Due to the spread of Corona epidemic in the entire country, the purpose of creating public awareness about masks, sanitizers and social distancing during the Corona epidemic period is from 15/10/20 to 30/10/20. Guided, it directly explained about the use of masks, sanitizers, importance of social distance. Before going out, people were made aware of the fact that if we actually use masks, sanitizers, social distancing, we can win over epidemics like Corona. In this regard, public awareness was created by visiting the residents. Volunteers conducted programs in the area where they live, in which nearly 50 volunteers participated.

Report No.06 - Celebration of Unity Day on the occasion of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel's birth anniversary -

On the occasion of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel's birth anniversary on 31/10/20, the government suggested celebrating Ekta Day in the country, accordingly volunteers worked with the local administration at the local level, convincing the village of the importance of Ekta Day on Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel's birth anniversary. He also went to the Anganwadi and participated in the immunization program for children. Volunteers conducted programs in the areas where they lived. In this work, 25 volunteers led and supported local women and children for vaccination.

Report No. 07- My Family My Responsibility – Direct Survey and Public Awareness -

During the period from 01/11/20 to 15/11/20, National Service Scheme volunteers worked with the local administration by conducting a survey and creating public awareness about My Family My Responsibility. It mainly includes stickers, use of masks, sanitizers, social distancing, etc. Explained the importance.
