1) TITLE OF THE PRACTICE

Students Internship program with Collaboration of Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education (MGNCRE), Hyderabad.

2. Objectives of the Practice -

To develop knowledge, skills and attitudes among interns to engage them with rural communities and issues.

To strengthen the capabilities and skills to enhance interest of interns for working with rural communities.

3. The Context -

The Placement Cell of the college has taken initiatives to connect MSW/ BSW Students with various Social Development Agencies for field work, Action Projects, Research and Internship programs. In this connection, 25 MSW I and II year students has applied for the two month paid internship program announced by Mahatma Gandhi National Council of Rural Education (MGNCRE), Hyderabad in the month of January 2023 and out of 25th 18th students selected and continued this rural internship program. The MGNCRE aims to strengthen the rural youth who is studying MSW - PG course to engage them with rural communities. The duration of internship program was two months and selected interns has paid Rs. 20000/- after successfully completion of the given task.

4. The Practice -

The prime objective of this internship program was to develop knowledge, skills and attitudes among interns to engage them with rural communities and issues. The aim of program was to Strengthening the capabilities and skills to enhance interest of interns for working with rural community. With this connection MGNCRE given task to the selected interns was to make videos on various social issues to highlight the role of social worker in various social issues. The coordinator of MGNCRE internship program conducts online meetings and interaction sessions with interns and provides guidelines for their work.

The college faculty members facilitate intern students to select the topics, discuss the selected social issues, recoding, framing dialogue and help to connect the task with the MSW course learning. These interns program develop Capacity and professionalizationskill development, awareness about entrepreneurship, livelihoods, sensitization about community initiatives, creativity of local groups and proactive development action.

- 2) 18 students participated in this program was fully motivated and built confidence of work as compare to rest of the students.

2. Objectives of the Practice -

The community engagement of social work students is the part of curricula but apart from that, the objective of this practice was to give orientation of community outreach programs to the students and enhance awareness of rural community on various issues.

3. The Context -

The college has NSS unit of 50 students which was affiliated with KBC NMU Jalgon and last three years NSS unit has been organized various programs at adopted village Ekrukhi Tq. Amalner Dist. 
5. Evidence of Success –
